- 1) Watch your step
- 2) Leave closing doors alone
- 3) If doors don't open, ring the alarm button and wait
- 4) If there is a fire in the building, use the stairs

Escalator & Moving Walk Safety Rules:

- 1) Step on and off carefully
- 2) People only no strollers
- 3) Hold the handrail
- 4) Take care of younger children
- 5) Do not touch the sides below the handrail
- 6) Stand facing forward
